- Deployed two DataPods for water quality monitoring
- Established dye tab testing program for marine sanitation systems

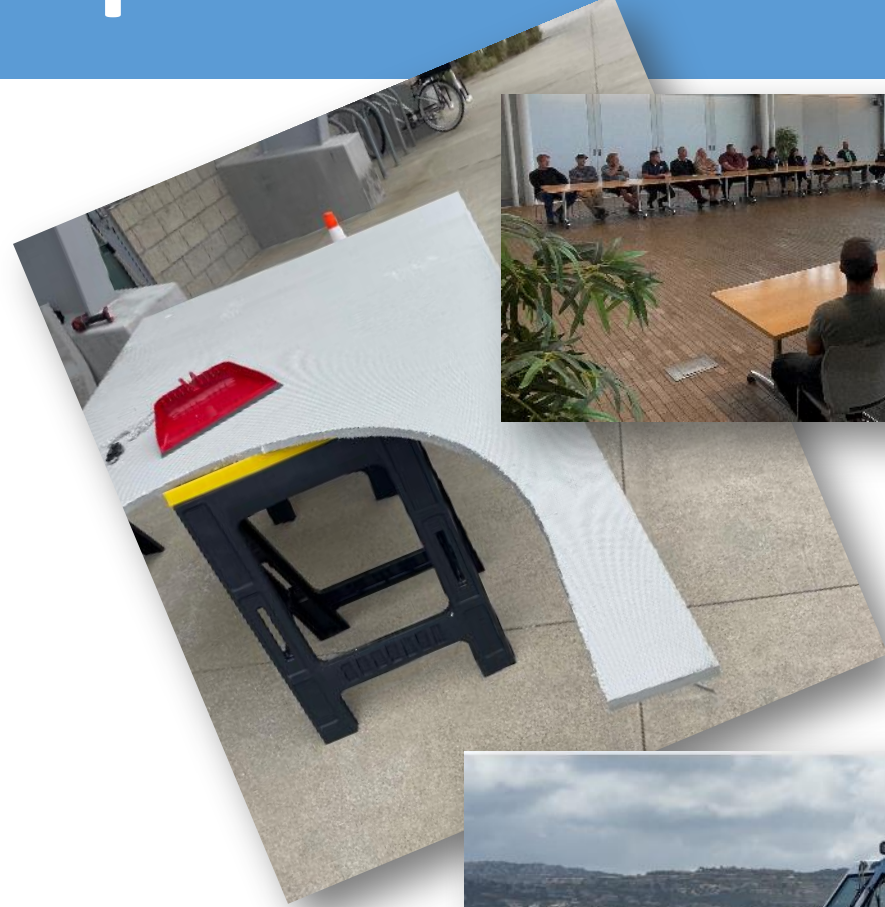




Recent Accomplishments

- **Permitted BIYC activities and beach storage for 10 year term**

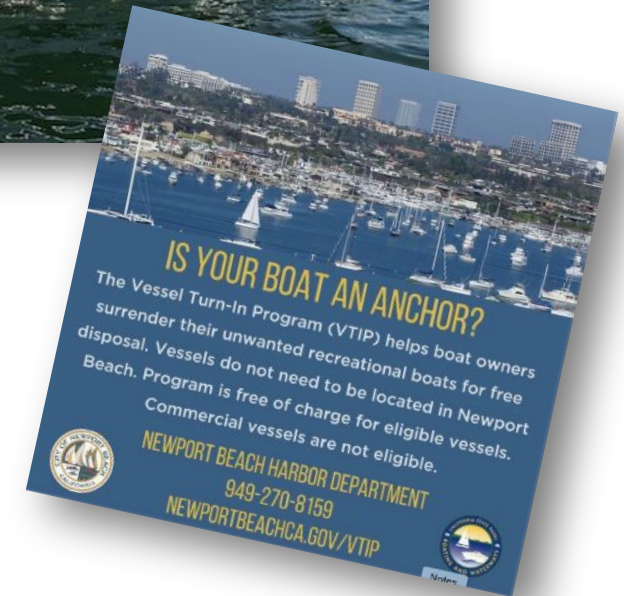




Recent Accomplishments

- Polished and refinished finials



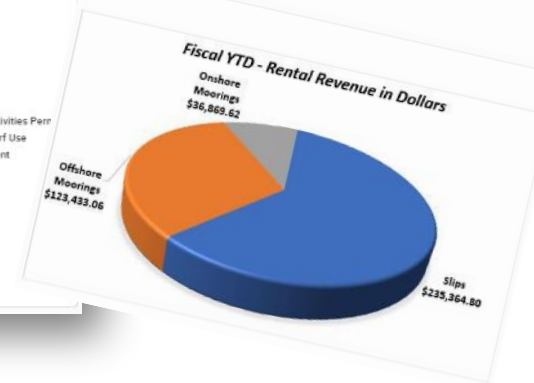
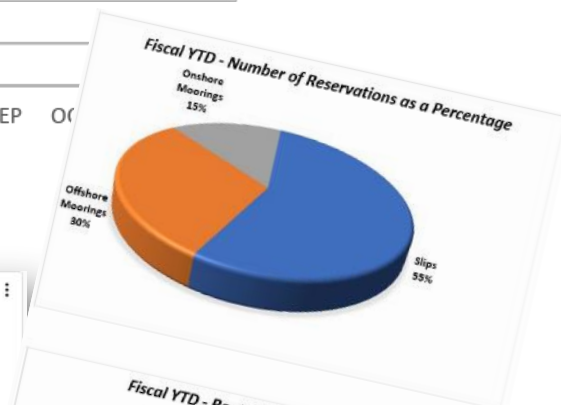
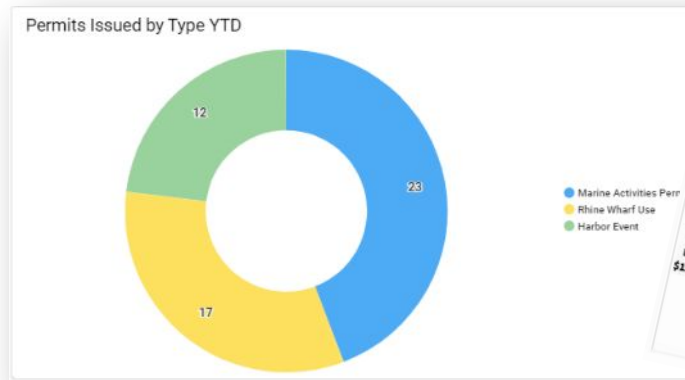
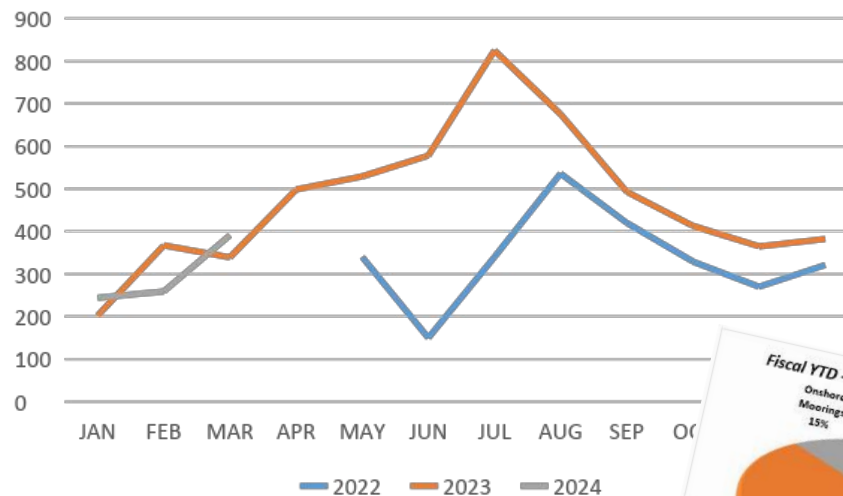

ODDS & ENDS

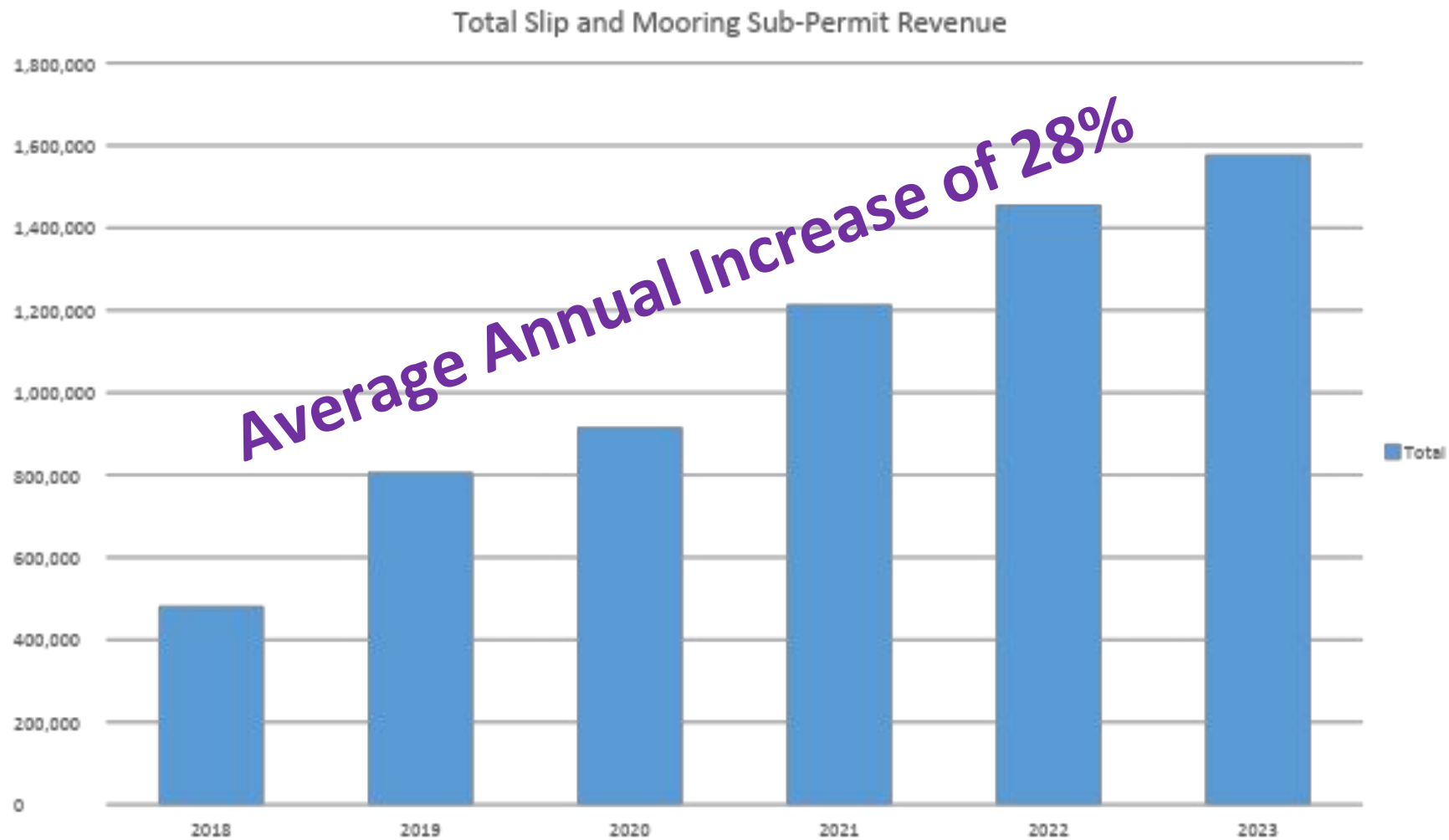
- Obtained proper registration for two patrol vessels and reinstated registration for the third patrol vessel
- Significantly increased variable revenue
- Implemented EnerGov for permitting

- Reduced six fees, added nine for new services offered

Habor Amenity Map Usage by Month





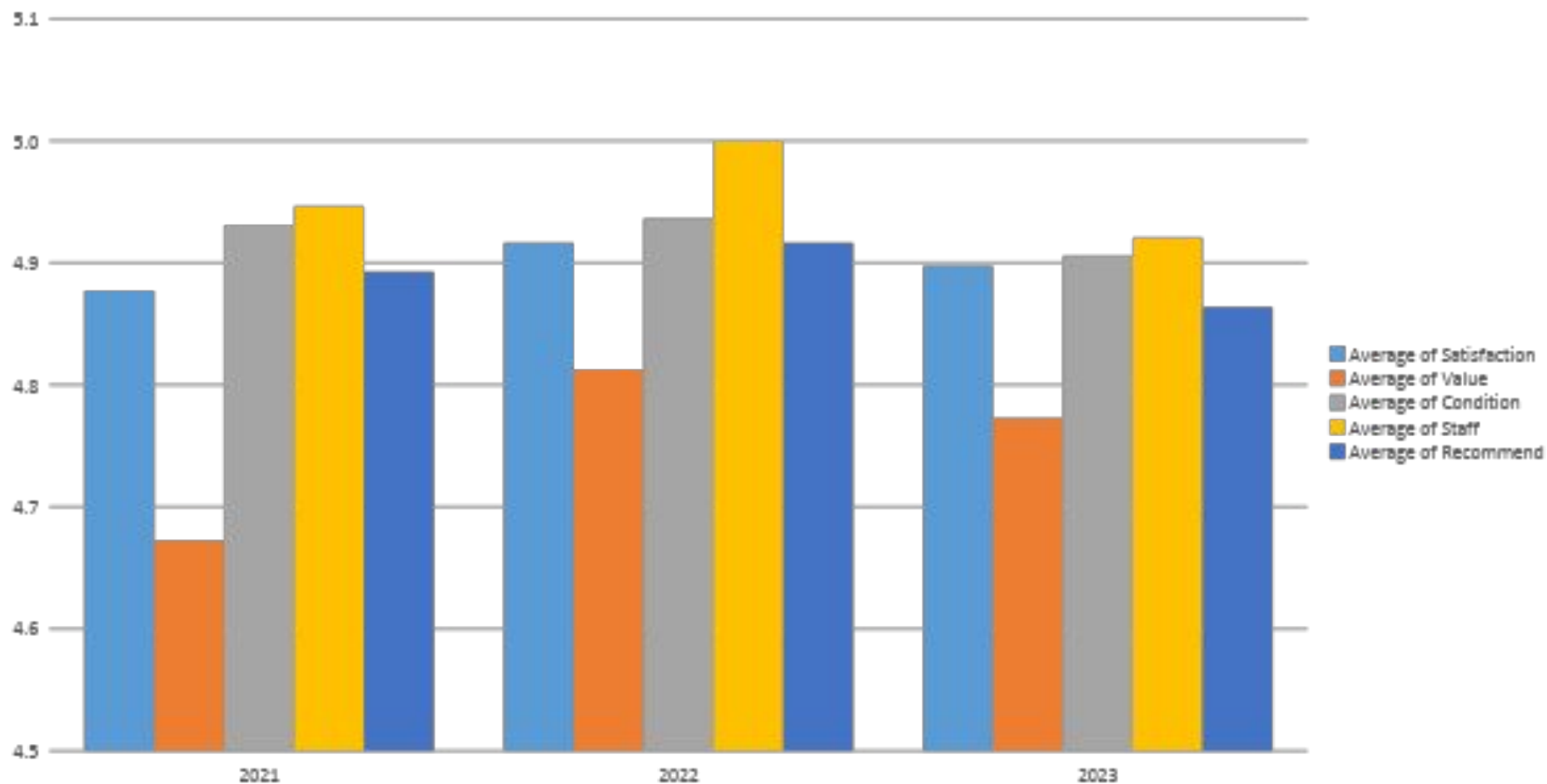

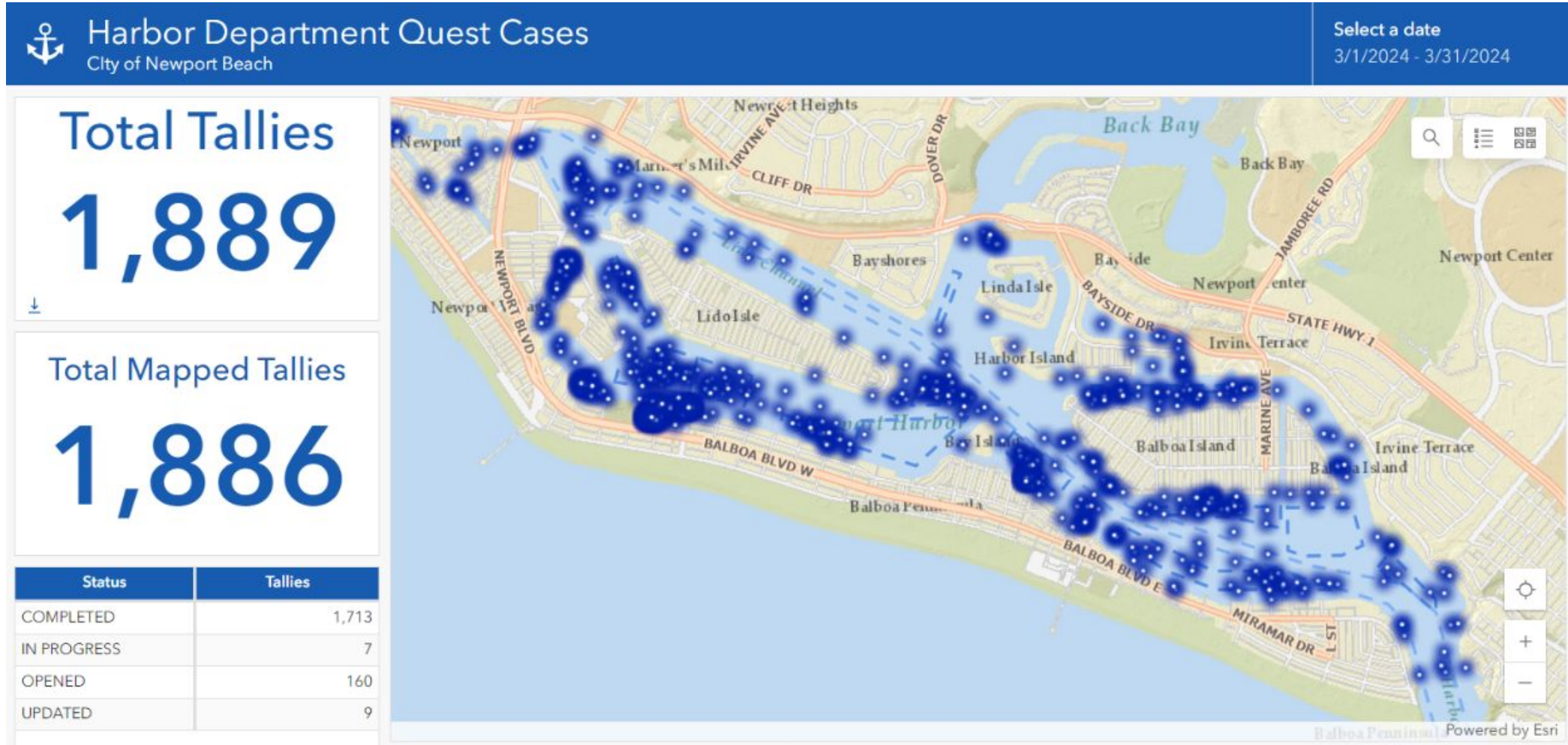

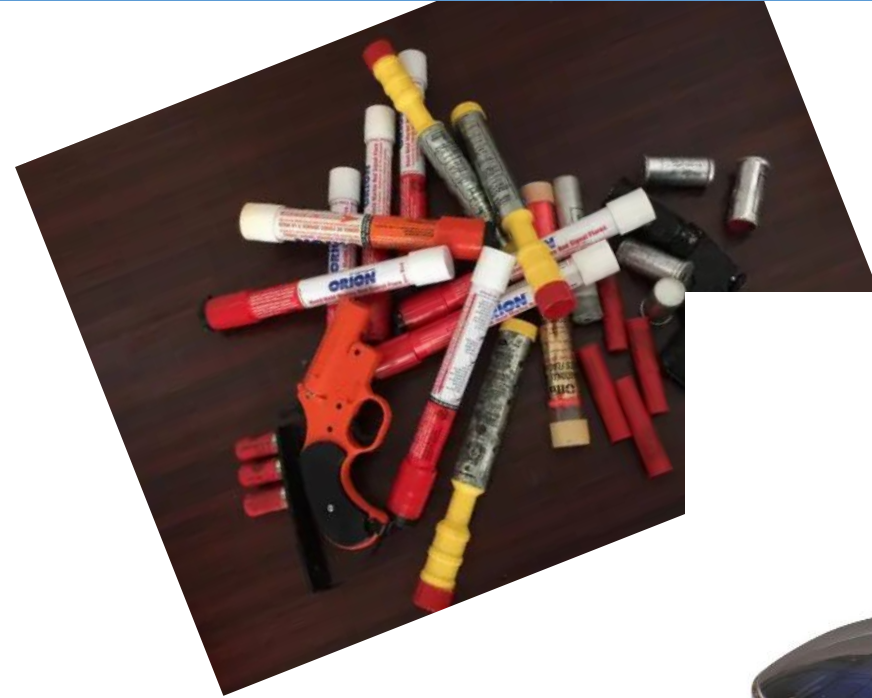
